DELTA PI EPSILON NATIONAL LEADERSHIP AWARD

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

Purpose of Award

The purpose of the DPE National Leadership Award is to recognize a DPE member for outstanding leadership and service to the national organization and the profession. The awardee will exemplify a commitment to promoting scholarship, leadership, and cooperation among professionals in education for business through leadership at the national level.

Who may qualify for the Award

The awardee may have served as a DPE national board member, a DPE national committee member, an editor or author of a DPE journal or publication, or an officer or committee member of a local chapter who has made a significant impact on the Society.

Guidelines for the National Leadership Award

1. A nationwide competition will be conducted each biennium.
2. The award, which consists of an engraved plaque, will be presented at the 2011 National Conference.
3. Travel expenses to/from the site of the National Conference, including transportation, one night's lodging and per diem, will be paid to the awardee.
4. The nominee must document significant leadership at the national level throughout his/her professional career.

Application Instructions

Prepare three (3) copies of the Leadership Award application form and include three (3) copies of the nominee's current vita/resume emphasizing leadership and service at the national level. A letter of nomination may highlight contributions and the impact on the Society. Send these to the Delta Pi Epsilon National Office by June 15, 2011. Send to:

Judging and Selecting the Awardee

A panel of three judges will be selected by the Awards Committee. Judges will be from chapters not represented among the nominees. Judges other than committee members may be selected to serve on the panel.

1. Upon receipt of the applications, the panel of judges will evaluate and award point values to each of the items listed on the Judging Criteria and Rating Sheet.
2. The nominee receiving the highest overall total points will be designated the awardee. In case of a tie, a second judging process will be conducted, and an awardee will be selected.
3. The awardee will be notified by the DPE National President.
4. The awardee will be invited to attend the 2011 National Conference at which time the award plaque will be presented.
5. The name of the awardee will be announced in the DPE newsletter.
